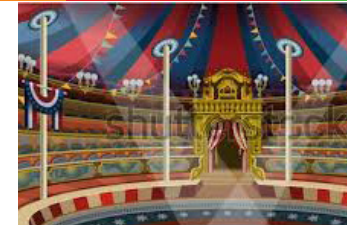
**Cost:** \$385 per child

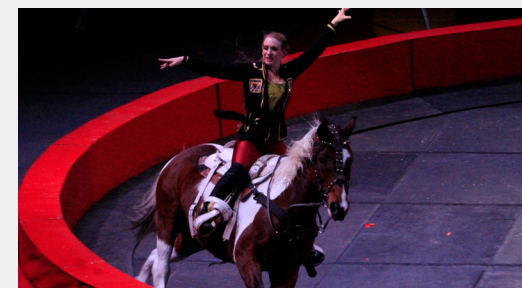
